legs get worms in them.

Chas: Yeah, everywhere.

Jack: That's what they do. It's true.

Chas: But that's all gone. Just a very few of them.

(Where there any old medicine men that had power to twist your face like that Ghost sickness?)

Daisey: No, they took it away but they didn't make them do that.

Chas: Fix you up. See, the spook get you. See, something like that.

(I knew they cold doctor it away but I didn't know if there's any men

/
that could make it happen to you.)

Chas: Oh, they could make you what they call--speaks in Kiowa--way back then. Yeah, they do things like that. They could make you cripple. They could make you paralyze or make you loose your mind, or something, you know.

Jack: Yeah, they do that.

Chas: Back there, olden--way back ahere. Yeah, they're crazy.

'(Mary says that she can doctor that twisted face?)

Chas: Yeah, -- speaks Kiowa to Daisey and mentions Mary Poafpybitty,

a LComanche doctor --

Daisey: Yeah, she is.

Jack: There are, but after awhile, they don't use it right. They go beyon Daisey: Them Wichitas and Caddos, they said they had one.

Jack: All that medicine—what you supposed to give them—instead of giving those things—they want money now. ((during this time Charles and Daisey are carrying on a conversation about medicine men)). —and maybe that's why it don't work when they doctor, it don't work. Some of them, you have to get them eagle feathers—maybe four eagle feathers, maybe
