with some of these Tonkawa boys. That's been going on and finally, lately on, there's--I'd say--about three or four of the Apache girls that married to Tonkawas. And that's why they got some children--like Molly Cisco. And this Helen Sunrise--lately named Sunrise--used to be Williams. And another one, Hope Berry from Frt Cobb, she got married. I don't think you know her. She's Philemon Berry's aunt or sister. And Alice--Alice Taw--she got married to Tonkawa. Oh, about four or five girls got married up there, and they got bunch of Tonkawa children now, and some living at Tonkawa yet. And Cisco, she's got children here. I think that's Roy Cisco, Buck Cisco, Vera, and Mildred, but she's dead now. They're all Tonkawas. That's the way it took place, that's how come these Apache girls got married to the Tonkawas. And some went back there. When the Tonkawas were going home, some went back with them down there to stay with them. They been married over there.

(Well, when they came down for this Ghost Dance, ws that before the country opened?)

No. No. That's been when we were alloted, you know. Here lately, you might say.

I ought to know theyears, but I never could learn them.

(About how old were you when that was going on?)

Oh, I was about nine years old. Of course I went to school when I was eight years old. I went to Catholic Mission. And that's when that Ghost Dance was going on ...

(And Molly LCisco met her husband about that same time?)

Yeah--no, no. Let's see. How could that be? Of course, they're older than me; and I was going to school. That's the way it went when the Tonkawas, they come down here. And when they got through dancing around here, they went back, and they took some girls back. Married. Yeah. I wish I could tell who all these (were). (I wish it was a better picture, too. It's sort of blurred in some places.)

Yeh, you could tell these women--they got something to give away. Probably all others are dancing in middle, too, and distance--out. This one sure looks like Jewell (Cisco), but I don't think he's that old. I wonder how old is he now.

This one standing here?

(Well, he'd have to be real old now. That picture was taken way back there.)
