So first time the woman coming in there and come in, walk to the water, before she do anything - why she - shot, they kill them right there. So the rest of them went back, run back, that's all they killed just one. Then we went, we went to - all to check Geronimo's hollering, I heard him holler. He said, "Down there's a little mountain - everybody goes to this little mountain there." So everybody goes in there. In that mountain there. Early in the morning we went down there. We was in that place for in the morning and afternoon about - about way in afternoon I guess. Might be about 3 o'clock - something like that. Well, Geronimo he holler, he call the men - his fighting men, so there's a soldier on the west side there, Mexican Army on the west side. Then there's American white man soldiers in that side, all they hold us right there. Then on the east side, Indian scouts that way, that's the way they hold us right there so we can't get away. So after awhile, Geronimo called the men together, he chose three men. He said, "You go to that Mexican Army." And this other fellow he says, "You go to that Mexican, white man's army, and you go to that scout, run him out of that mountain." So they all - everybody - those three men they went out. I seen that fellow up there, I could see. One fellow there, he's a fighting with about - over a thousand soldiers, Mexican Army. He just go
