(Who offered? Who did that?)

Puritars. Began by offering cash for the heads of their enemies. Later accepting scalps and both ears were attached. The French were the first to offer bounties for the scalps of white people, with the English quickly following suit. And such vast sums were expended that scores of the white man took up the lucrative business of hunting scalps. Scalps were paid as much \$52 to \$150 by the French and English.

FINER CHARACTERI\$TICS OF THE CHEYENNES

The Indian was first of all a hunter, not a warrior. As history books tell.

As the history book stated. For upon his ability in this direction, depended his living and early training, and games were all designed to teach him skill in hunting. All old Chevennes seems to know everything, names of stars in heaven and in the milky way. They could tell what the weather was to be in advance even in one year ahead. By the study of the nature. The seasons plants the actions of birds, the animal life. The Cheyennes were also paint makers.

Make dyes and beautiful colors from the wild berried barks, and from the earth. We had doctors, not witch doctors, they gathered their medicine in the forests on the prairies, in the ground were they cure vast human elements and I understand they cured the headache by punching a certain blood vein in the head, allowed blood to drain for a short moment. This stopped the persons' headache. I have seen this performed. Today's modern medicines are gathered from a same source. The Cheyennes also know that perfume weed for its use. We also had hide tanners that know modern machine of today has--

(Perfume weed?)

Uh-huh.

(There's an Indian perfume isn't it that they use isn't it? That the Indians had, didn't they, a breath prifier that they use?)

Yeah. They had what they call Bitter Medicine, that's what they call that.
(Bitter Medicine?)
