Subject: Indian wood craftsmanship. Making spinning wheels,
furniture, clap-board shingles.
Tools of the era.
Building log houses
Early stores in Indian Territory.
"White man hunts for gold supposed to be hidden
by prosperous Indians".
Early-day farming.

Note: Tape in recorder stuck after 38 minutes and interview was
stopped. Tape would not rewind or go forward from Index
side B, but did rewind when operated from Side A. It was
