Yeah, yeah he was raised over here about three mile. (m-hum. Can you remember any chiefs before him?) Huh? (Can you remember any chiefs before Belvin was chief?) No, Durant was the last guy I could remember. (I don't know--) And Dwight. Dwight was one of 'em. And Durant was one of 'em. And Minmy-something-+ (And Jimmy's been for sometime but I don't know who was chief just before he was. That's something I'm sure you could find someplace but I don't know right off. Well, your birds sing. Hear the birds?) Oh yes, uh huh. They come, all kinds of birds. Stay round the berries, you know. · Even quail come up here. Good notion to shoot quail. (um-hum.) Never did shoot at 'em; (CHOCTAW LANGUAGE: (Can you talk Choctaw?) That's all I can talk. (Well, you've been talking English to me.) That's all I know. And any books too. I can't read about anything in English. I can read pretty good in our language (M-hum. You gotta Chockaw Testament?) Yeah, I got a Choctaw Testament. I gotta Choctaw--part of it. Part of a Bible, you know. About five books. No, about ten books, I think old books. (I've seen a Bible, a songbook and a Testament. And that's all I 've ever seen in Chocctaw. You can buy 'em though. I didn't know you could buy new ones. I didn t know until today that you could bjy new Choctaw songbooks.) Yeah, I think they still sell it cause I seen peoples buyin it all the time. New

ones, you know. I just have one and had it for years and years.
