I was a little boy, but I was enough to see and you know, some of them doctors come down over there and they heard that she passed away and four--John Blue Hawk, I talked to Frankie Davis that day. And Harry Caesar and Riding In and I think it was Little Walk, four of them they come down there. And when they went down there over there well they got her like you say, took her down--right middle way that's where we get our drinking water. Took her down there and they all got enough water over there. Two of them in the middle you know and them on the side. (Pawnee word), Ramona, side. They got gourds, big fans. They sing. They come back and turn around and come back this way, four times, sing. But it just too late you know. They took her back. It was too late. Took her back to tent, that's the only one I saw.
