heart. 'Cause they do need heart to live when they come here. And all these things here are like they got now. I just come out here."

(Come out of the world to here?)

That's the way I believe it. That's enough, they ain't got clothes on. They don't want the rich people. They want the poor people. My wife die, I don't know where she went to. I don't know where I am going to find her. She'd been sick. I been sick a little while. Sent back to hospital. I have to go somewhere in Alaska. Then I have heart trouble ever since. They just give me medicine. They told me not to drive a car, but I go ahead and drive it. (One sentence not clear.)

INDIAN FOOD

(Wild onions and ...)

Wild onions and eggs.

(Wild greens - what kind of greens do you find now, this time of year?)

Well, the only one that I know is wild onions. We used to have some kind of a greens a long time ago - can't find any now. Used to be a lot of them over here where the dam is now.

(Mushrooms coming up now?)

Yeah.

(How many different kinds of mushrooms are there that you can eat?)
Oh, about three.

(Which ones are they?)

Some of them you only find in winter time. They're big. I don't know what they call them. The other is white. See them on top of tree. That is a nice one right over yonder. That big.

(Grows on the side of trees?)

Yeah. You have to slice it like chicken.
