him by--took him away back in the sticks, where there would be just the two of them. And he doctored him and most generally in cases like that, they doctored them for 14 days. And after 14 days why Joe Buck was up and around. Dr. Knight saw him in town and he said he just couldn't believe his eyes. He said he just had to go up and talk to him. He talked to him and Joe told him that he was well and out again. And he wanted to know how it happened and Joe Buck told him that this old Indian man took him out, away back in the sticks and doctored-him and he got well. And Dr. Knight asked this Joe Buck what he used. If he would just only tell him that, what kind of herbs he used, he would give him \$500.. And he had \$500.00 in his hand and told him, he said, "I'll give you all this, if you'll just tell me what kind of herbs he used." And Joe Buck told Dr. Knight, "I could tell you and show you the herbs that he used but," he said, "You have to know the Indian chant they chanted and they put lot of faith and trust in God when they make medicine." So all the Indians and things that we hear about Indian medicine is true. And they didn't take it upon themselves, knowing these things that they made medicine, but they believe in God--they believe in God from the beginning, because even though that when they didn't know God, they knew was -- they was a Creator, there was a Maker, in the form of the spirit. And when they worshipped they most was early in the morning, during the form of the spirit. And when they worshipped the most was early in the morning, during the fog or dense air. They'd go out and worship. And when they taught the younger Indians these Indian medicine-why they ache, they fasted for it, just like we, the Christians people do today, for their wisdom and learning. From the Bible; Christians people do today, for their wisdom and learning. Our Indians do too but today why it's not anything like it was even 10-15 years ago. Things have changed a great deal. (Charley, didn't you tell me earlier than John Stamp used a buzzard feather

to clean--)
