(Do you remember where they used to go--or what it would be near now?)

Let's see. A little place there north of Red River--Faxon. Some-where around Faxon.

(Would it be right down on the river--or?)

Near the river bottom, yeah.

(Did you ever see that plant yourself?)

Yeah, I saw it.

(What does it look like--the top of it?)

Oh, it looks something like an apple tree, only very much smaller.

It had larger leaves than a plum, but plums were more round, like.

I mean the leaves were more round. It didn't grow more than that

high.

(It grew about four feet high?) . ,

Yeah, what I saw. Some might grow higher.

(Did it ever have any kind of flowers on it?)

No, I never know that. I saw it in August. It might have had buds or fruit or something.

(Did you ever notice any fruit?)

No.

(What color were the leaves?)

Green. Kind of a grayish-green.

(Were the leaves big?)

No, about so big. Like a peach leaf.

(Were there lots of them down there?)

Well, here and there they might grow in bunches, but what I saw was just two or three. Kind of a sandy, not very high knoll, but sandy, but I saw three or four of them. And I saw where two or
