Well, still the agency ought to supervise that, see, instead of hiring out another man, see. He had to pay this man. He doesn't know if he got his full amount of money, that this man used his money right for him or not. See, just like--the man told him, well we're going to buy you some cattle. Well, alright, well he don't know how much he paid for his cattle or he don't know what he got when he sold 'em. He doesn't know how much he got for 'em.
