Albert Horse became ministers in the Methodist Church. And then all the rest of the childrens become and were baptised some in the Baptist Church and in the Methodist Church. That's how he found the Lord. And he's always has been a great leader, that he saw his mistake. He saw his mistake of how he worshiped the wrong way. But he always had said in his prayer that he has find the right way of worshipping God--the living God in heaven. Calls that a Great Spirit. That's all.
