DELAWARE AND OSAGE SMOKES.

Fred: Well, they used to have those out west of Copan, over here. This little town of Copan, right west of there, about two miles, I guess. On top of the hill, they used to have smokes up there. And they'd go on for two weeks lot of times. Yeah.

And when the Osage come over here, well, the Delawares would give them - they were to have one day left to give their stuff to their friends. Well, lots of times they would give them horses, blankets, just whatever they wanted to give them. And they'd have a big time, dance every night, and they'd have a big go around. Then the next year, well then, the Delawares would go over there to Pawhuska, over around in there somewhere, I guess Pawhuska. They'd go over there and they'd have a smoke over there and they would do the same thing there. And then they give alot of horses away there, different kinds. And they'd have races. And they'd have everything like that.
