Fred: Yeah, there is. That's, that's - now they' intermarried into the Caddo, and the Wichita. They was two different tribes they married into down there. Now some of them down there are half Delaware and half Caddo. There's some, half Delaware and half Wichita - Wichita down there, but I believe that's 'bout all they married into down there, but they wasn't quite a few Delaware down there, not a lot of 'em, but there are quite a few down there. 'Course they talk Delaware just like we do up here.

Katherine: (Is this the only two settlements of Delawares around here?) **Fred:** It is around in here. Yeah, we just a few of us here and a few around Dewey, you know, a few at, Bartlesville. Like Esther now, they're over around Delaware and Nowata, and there's a few Delaware in there. Now this Horace McCracken, he's our chairman of our Delaware business committee, 'course he lives in Bartlesville there. He's the chairman of the Delaware business committee, he looks after that.
