a ruler in her hand and if I made a mistake, she would hit me on top of the hand. It would hurt and I got to where I would try not to make a mistake and that would keep a person from making a mistake too if they find they was gonna get their hands hit. She was a good teacher. She was—she knew her music and she really was good. She was stern, but she was good. We had quite a few things to keep us busy out there; going to school, we learned a lot of things. We had a Mrs. Milton Rosabin that used to come out once a week to give dancing lessons.
