Jenny: So when they got across, this buffalo said, "Now we're across, you go on out." But Sainday had different plans. When he was in there he got his knife out and cut his insides up. And he went and killed this buffalo. And he got out and he butchered that buffalo after he saved his life.

Cecil: It means he's the best cheater. He's nothing but a cheater,
