man will be wanting you. You'll be so ugly, why nobody don't want to care for you." So he witch this woman. (speaks Kiowa)—that spoil her looks. Now what he witch her with, I don't know. But just the same, he witch that woman. So you know how, see a woman with red nose. You know that look like that. Of course, the doctor says it's bad blood that gives them that but the Indians, they witch.

(Was that very long ago?)

Cecil: Yeah, it happen along about 1900--about 1891 or '92. Some where in there. That man was still living when I was little. He was--.

(What was his name?)

Cecil: Todwkw and that was-he was a bad fellow, that fellow. (Oh, really?)

Cecil: Lots of people laid for him and was gonna kill him. But there was another witch woman from Wichita got mad at him and kill him. Witched him.

(Oh, how did she manage to do that?)

Cecil: Huh?

(How did she do that?)

Cecil: Well, that woman she witched him with, I think it was either, a needle or sinew, either one. But that fellow found out that this old lady, Wichita tribe woman, that she witched him. They were trying to get the best of each other--which one is the best witch. She said, "I am. I know more than you do." He said, "No, you're not. You're a woman. You don't know nothing." So she just showed him and witched him. He got sick and about died. But he went down
