Yeah about three miles . And it was more of a higgers side than anything.

Nigger town they called it. Hardly ever on Saturday what we lived there by Melvin: That there wasn't two or three of them killed on Saturday.

(Well.)

They'd get up there you know. And get to gambling and drinking or something.

(Yeah. What creek is -- is that Fourteen Mile Creek that runs through Hulbert or Clear Creek?)

Fourteen Mile Creek.

(Uh-huh.)

No wait a minute. Wait a minute. I've got that wrong. It was Double Spring Creek that runs through. Fourteen Mile Creek comes up and about a mile west of Hulbert. And then it goes north.

(th-huh.)

It comes around by Coxes. On up that away. You know.

(Yeah.)

Through Gideon down here.

(Yeah.)

On up. The head of it is right there at (not clear). Right there at (not clear).

(Uh-huh, that's Gideon that's another old place. Isn't it.)

GIDEON WAS A SMALL TOWN

Yeah Gideon's an old place. Been a store at Gideon ever since I've known that place.

(Yeah.)

When I was just a small kid. We moved up in about three miles from Gideon west there. And we got to getting our mail at Gideon. There was a post office there.
