(Which one is Richard?)

This one.

(This fellow name's Enoch, this one here?)

Uh-huh. This one named Lewis. I don't know these two.

(You know they were saying that -- Josephine was saying, that the Caddo's, they follow some man named Enoch someone--)

But that's him right there. This old man right here. Is that-

(Enoch someone. It's on--)

It couldn't be Enoch Murphy could it?

(Huh-uh.)

Enoch somebody else. And I have another picture here that is one of the Osage Ledies from Pawhuska. Her name was Josephine West (77). And her sister Mary. Her name is Josephine Cunningham. I don't remember what her sister's name is today, but they both did live in Pawhuska.

(This is here is who?)

Josephine and that's Mary. Her sister that have white hair today. Have you seen her?

(No. Josephine and Mary.)

Um-huh. This is very very nice picture. I am just so sorry to say that I don't know these ladies (79). I think I know one, I got to lookin' at her. Clothes—she's fully dressed in beautiful Osage clothes. She has a beautiful broadcloth skirt and leggings and mocassins and Indian shirt and her pins and beads. And she is also wearing earrings. I think she's Miss McFall, of Pawhuska.

(Mary McFall?)

Um-huh. This one right here. And this one I know her too, but I think she's Cora--
