1. A hairball from the stomach of a buffalo.

A buffalo tail, or hair from the tail, with hide, folded over a fan made of feathers from a bird called pape. In Kiowa. These were probably the tail feathers of a redshafted flicker. They were rather short feathers, sharppointed, black on the ends, and the main part of the feather was orange and red.

3. Fan used when singing while doctoring. This was also a rattle. It was made of:

a. Tips of buffalo hoofs, which made the rattle sound.

b. Buffalo hair, plaited.

- c. Buffalo tail. I think the fan was constructed around this buffalo tail--other items fastened to it.
- d. Many feathers I could not identify (they looked old).
- e. A small buckskin sack containing ground red paint.

4. Wad of buffalo hair.

5. A bell.
