And there's so many Indians employed there now. Government give some eight hundred and seventy thousand dollars to build this if they'd hire so many Indians (words not clear) and they did.

Poston is big, it is a nice cemetery. Real nice. I noticed that when I was up there. Got lot more land around it then fenced it over for (words not clear).
