(Unclear) ask me to give that to her over there, why, there's was one fella that had a recorder over there. He took part of that. He couldn't get it'all, but he said (not clear) didn't want to do that until after they'd announced, see. Well, he had to grab the tape recorder just as quick as they could they got part of it. But he got that part of it alright. So, Randy, of course, he was listening that when he told 'em he wanted to listen, see if he could understand it. But he said he did, he understood lot of it. But Leonard now, he talks Shawnee, too. They both talk Shawnee. Leonard, I think he's retired now. He lives down in Tulsa. Well, he don't live in Tulsa, he lives in Sperry.

(Sperry.)

Yeah. North.

(Leonard LongBone.)

Huh?

(I that Leonard LongBone.)

Leonard Carpenter.

(I mean Leonard Carpenter.)

That's Randy's brother. But I think he retired, I don't know if they are going to live over there, or move or somewhere. I don't'know which. They got the wife's place over there where they live now. Well, seems like they were going to move though. They weren't going to stay there. No, I believe it's his brother-in-law's place. His wife's brother, well, he stays with 'em you see. He's blind, almost blind now, I think he's blind by now. Stays with him. His name's Louis, her name is (not clear) .
