Shady Point Cemetery, (Choctaw)

J. B. Jackson, a former Secretary of State for the Choctaw Nation, lies buried in the cemetery which is owned by the unincorporated town of Shady Point and is located near the center of that village.

The grave is unmarked save by a rough native stone at the head and foot.

The grave was shown and identified to me by a Mr. Ward who resides nearby and as a Mason participated in the burial.

It adjoins the marked grave of Madine Mixon immediately on the suth and is the third in a row of Mixon graves extending northward from it, all of which have lettered stones which will serve to identify the tomb of Jacob Jackson, should future

occasion ever require it.

The legal description of the property is as follows: N. E. 4, N. W. 4, N.E. 4, Section 34, T. 8 N., R. 25 E.
