to be made known to me.

Believing that you have the interest of your people
at least & that you are the proper person to
discriminate rightly, offences which tend to a derelic-
tion from a lawful course & to degrade the nation
I have been induced to satisfy your people
by this Appointment & Mah-he, a h. tubbed for
efficiency as a soldier, is recommended for your Lieu-
tenant. The appointment of your Company will otherwise
be left to you.
