Yours of 2 inst is now before me, the Bill that is before Congress did not come, every body have received a copy, but my self, I have seen it and am more than pleased with it, I have seen several Chickasaw half Blood all are in favour of it I shall be down ~~to~~ about, T. Tolson, next week and will be at the Circuit Court, I am determin to rise or fall under it, I am going to do all I can for it I shot gun for the next Council, if alive If the Chortaws do not, - except this Bill, I am done with them for ever, and will have no hopes for them here after, as we must educate our children education is all that can save the Chortaws, Col Pickens and others of the Chickasaws, will start for that City, tomorrow, and if I have a chance to send this by any one of the delegations I will do so,

I have not bin from home, in a
long time, my health is now
improving very rapidid, I am
determined to take care of my
self I shall go to the air springs
about the first of May, my folks
are all well I have not heard
from Mountain fork in a long
time, I heard that Howell
had his Barn burnt down and
lost his dwelling houses,
Daniel Tolson, I suppose heard was
married to a white woman
He is one of the women that
stoped at the depot some time
ago, I am in hopes that he
is contented, the woman that he
had at Bayggs, some young man
came along, and took her off, and
he came up in a few days, and found
her not, returned back to Lookout
ville, and married in a few days
It was a quick match, I am told
all in a moment, I do not like
this quick work,
Mary, is still here with me, and as
fat as a Bone, Morten is here and
has bin for sometime, he appears
to get up to her, very close

he says that I must tell you that if you do not look out that he will cut you out, he has been busy yesterday since he has been here Pitman Godberts, widow is sewing the ares for her portion of property

There is more sewing for property now than a little, I was told that since P.G. Love has left home that they had took his negroes and I suppose will try to have a trial for it at the next court our old friend Jack Finckiss is no more, also Amos Eastman died a short time since,

there was 2 officers killed not long ago near Court Bell nap by 2 Cickapoos, one of them has been killed by his own party since the other made his escape.

I am told that the Comanches have taken all the cattle and horses at Bell nap - was camped

near the Court, it was fully believed that they would make an attack on the Court, there was about 60 soldiers in the Post and it is fully believed that all is killed before this,

I am in hopes that the Government
will put a stop to all the settlers
at the Fourt, in this nation, of making
farms and raising corn and stock
on the reserve, here are white
men living in our country-making
large farms, taken all the con-
tracts, and no chance for the
Cherokees, here is a man by
the name of Stuke living on
the reserve at Washaton, he has
a negro wife and I am told
that he harbors all the runaway
negroes, and a great place for
the negroes, to meet on Sunday
he has a large farm and stock
I think something ought to be
done in such cases.
