

5th Mo & 7th Mo 1873

30th 2nd day Clear & Warm

7th Mo Remained in camp most of the day

1st 3rd day Clear but Windy

In camp all day

2nd 4th day Clear, All day in camp

3rd 5th day Clear Lodges all down
for moving against Sunrise. Started a-
gainst half past Six. It is pleasant
to be moving toward the agency even
though it be but slowly. To day
we traveled for miles in the bed of
the stream it being dry. Went in
to camp on the South side of the
Peepoh (where we were encamped
when I went into the ^{agency} the last
time) about 11 o'clock P.M.

4th 6th day Clear & Pleasant

So far out of the way of civilized
life that I hear nothing of all the
follies with which this anniver-
ary is attended among the masses
of American people, the morning
is ushered in by the busy scraping
of the women in preparing skins
for lodges, while their dignified lords
are slumbering upon their couches.

Long before the Sun rises they
are busy, so as to get their work done
while it is cool. Did not leave
camp to day except for a walk.

5th 7th day Clear Lodges mostly
down against Sunrise for moving

Started about 7 o'clock, went
into camp about 11 o'clock near
~~the~~ the place of our first encamp-
ment on the Peepoh, which is dry
