Registered my name at the Lawrence House where I remained last night & shall make my home while remaining here. Very weak & trifling.

10<sup>th</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> day Clear & Pleasant

Attended meetings after which went to Superintendent Hoags, spent afternoon & night there.

11<sup>th</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> day Clear in the forenoon, afternoon showers around. Took the cars at 2 P.M. for Cedar Rapids, arrived at Columbus junction between 4 & 5 o'clock A.M. of the

12<sup>th</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> day Clear & Pleasant

Waited at Columbus junction until 11 o'clock A.M. for the Cedar Rapids train, arrived at Cedar Rapids just in time for the train for Iowa, where I arrived about three, twenty P.M. found Father there with conveyance ready to take me home, where my family were anxiously awaiting my arrival, & we were mutually rejoiced in being again permitted to meet in mutual fellowship.

Continued sick & about home until 5<sup>th</sup> Mo 28<sup>th</sup>
