The Indians have been recovered but not near one half of them. There are two others who were engaged in this horse stealing business who have not yet been caught.

4th 3rd day Clear & Pleasant. Worked in the Office.

5th 4th day Cloudy. Not very well. Worked in the Commissary's Office in forenoon. P.M. went out to hunt for Pecans.

~~5th 5th day~~ Received letter No 5 from home.

6 5th day Cloudy. Not well. did some work in the Office.

7th 6th day Cloudy Clear & Warm. Worked in the Office. P.M. Rode with Howards to the Drs & to the Post.

Wrote home No 7

8th 7th day Clear. Worked in the Office most of the day.

9th 1st day Clear & Pleasant. Attended meeting, school &c. Evening Agent Haworth returned from his trip to Lawrence.

10th 2nd day Clear & Pleasant. Not well. Rode out to the Post & to the School.

11th 3rd day Clear but Windy. Not well. Remained at the Agency. Kicking Bird came in with some other Kiowa Chiefs.

12th 4th day Clear & cool. Kicking Bird is ready for me to go out to camp, to day. Wrote home No 8 preparatory to going out to camp with him.
