

2nd Mo. 1874

- 4th 4th day, Cloudy, Started on without waiting for the other wagons & reached the Kiowa Camp on the Washita about 3.30 P.M. Soon after which it began to rain. Heavy feeling in stomach
- 5th 5th day Rainy This evening Kicking Bird arrived with the trading teams of Remained in & about camp
- 6th 6th day Clear, & not very cold In camp
- 7th 7th day Clear & Pleasant, In camp Unwell though as this gnawing heavy feeling in my stomach is so nearly constant, I need not mention it
- 8th 1st day Clear, but windy In camp
- 9th 2nd day Clear, In camp
Wrote to C. & Ruth
- 10th 3rd day Clear Started about 11 o'clock for the Agency, camped again at the head of Cache Creek
- 11th 4th day Clear Arrived at the Agency found one letter from home. Some of the Comanches drawing annuities
- 12th 5th day Cloudy At the Agency
wrote home No 20
- 13 6th day Clear, Worked in the office
- 14th 7th day Clear, At the Agency
- 15th 1st day Clear, ~~Wrote home No 20~~ Attended, both meetings
In the latter I ventured to speak a few words, to my which was followed by a very comfortable feeling in my own particular
- 16th 2nd Cloudy & toward night Raining Went to the Wichita Agency accompanied by two of the School Boys viz Levi Frank & Joe Washington Found Agent Richards & the family of employees well & the school progressing satisfactorily, Several Kiowas are in at this Agency
