

3rd Mo 1876

- 25th 4th day Cloudy, very unwell, Wrote home, No 26, Went to the shops. Evening Agent returned
- 26th 5th day Clear At the Agency, Not well. Received another letter from home, also one from E. H. Stanley
- 27th 6th day Clear At the Agency, Not well Agent returned last night
- 28th 7th day Clear Started for the Wichita Agency, to assist the Philadelphia Friends in getting here. Proceeded to about a mile beyond Cache Creek Station where I met J. Richards, with J. Wistar, Wm. Pickrel & C. Beede, so I turned about & came back with them. Dr. Rhodes & M. C. Cope having been left at the Cheyenne Agency
- 29th 8th day Cloudy. Attended meetings &c
- 30th 9th day Cloudy with a refreshing shower this evening. Thomas Wistar called the members of Society employed at this Agency together this afternoon, as a parting opportunity intending to go to the Wichita Agency tomorrow. Arrangements have been made for a council near the Wichita Agency, with the Indians of this Agency
- 31st 10th day Cold & Cloudy. Thunder Showers last evening. Started for the Wichita Agency in company with Thomas Wistar & Wm. Pickrel, the wind was strong & facing us, which rendered the travelling extremely uncomfortable, but we arrived there about 5 o'clock, without suffering much from the cold, found Dr. J. C. Rhodes & Marmaduke C. Cope, already there. Put up at the School House
