

5th Mo 1876

2nd 7th day Clear with high wind, becoming cold toward evening

Remained in Camp

3rd 1st day Cloudy & cold In Camp

4th 2nd day Clear & cool In Camp

Today Am looking at a herd of ponies & mules belonging to the Comanches, being just across the creek from camp. I noticed several american horses, & two mules particularly, with the mane worn off by working in the collar & the hair worn off the sides by the trace showing that some poor man in Texas had been robbed of his team in the midst of doing his Springs work

Received word to day that Satanta & Running Bear, & the chiefs who were encamped with them have refused the proposition of the Comanches to join them in raiding & murder this summer, but that Momans Heart is favorable to joining them in ^{their} depredations in Texas. So that among the Kiowas the following named chiefs ^{have} are ^{of} from positive information, refused to listen to the proposition viz Kicking Bird, Stumbling Bear, Trotting Wolf, Quoi-sun-beat, Quo-i-bode Feather Head, Look-hauson, Satanta, Dangerous Eagle, Crow Neck, Running Bear & Kaw-tome, & Old-pack-quo-i-see, information, is not equally positive, though pretty certain that Poor Buffalo & Sun Boy will also reject it while from the other Kiowa chiefs I have no information, making 15 opposed to raiding, & 6 in favor of it & 6 unknown

5th 3rd day Clear Today Sun Boy & Old-pack-quo-i-see & their people arrived on their way to the Agency. White Wolf was also in camp & made a talk to
