9th 3rd day Clear, Warm, Not well

At the Agency

10th 4th day Clear Warm Went to the Shops

11th 5th day Cloudy & cool, Rain last night accompanied by Wind, lightning & thunder P.M. Agent Rickards, J. D. Hoag, & Dr. Grennell came here from the Wichita Agency.

Pacer sent in word that the Cheyennes & Comanches are contemplating an attack upon the Agency.

12th 6th day Day, visited the hospital in company with Drs. Given & Grennell. P.M. Rode out to Medicine Bluffs

13th 7th day Cloudy Not at all well
The friends from the Wichita Agency left this morning.

Asa Soyett yesterday came to the Agency considerably excited in consequence of word having been sent to him by the other Comanches that they were intending to kill him in consequence of his long continued friendship to the Whites.

He has made up his mind that if they do come in to force him to join them or take his life he shall attempt to get ^{into} the Cherokee country, with the civilized Indians & remain there until the storm blows over. Not well

14th 8th day Clear Attended Meeting
Very unwell

15th 9th day Cloudy Rained last night
Very warm, Not well, Wrote home No 37

16th 10th day Clear & Warm, Weak & trifling, Some
Kiwias came in this evening
