17th 4th day Clear & Warm, Weak & trifling
went to the shops Revil letter 3 y

18th 5th Clear & Hot, Unwell, Assisted at
the Bakery Issuing Bread

19th Knowas in for nation, except a
few bands, report Lone Wolf with the
Cheyennes & Comanches. The friend-
ly chiefs express their determination
of coming in ^{near} to the agency if the
others go off & join the War party of
the Cheyennes & Comanches

19th 6th day Foggy in the morning
but cleared off, Very Warm

Went to the shops Unwell
A couple of horsethieves, arrested
near Cheyenne Agency were brought
to the post this evening. There appears
to be a large gang of desperados in the
portion of Country up northwest of that
Agency, & extending into the Pan Handle
of Texas who are arranging, as near as
I can learn to fix their headquarters
in Texas Pan Handle as actual settlers
where they can, by being remote from
all other settlements, carry on their
reparious designs of selling whiskey,
arms & ammunition to the Indians
stealing & buying stolen horses of Indians
thereby giving them encouragement, in
raiding against more peaceably disposed
settlements.

22nd 9th day Clear & Hot, At the Agency Wrote home 1000
