who was then and is now employed  
in the school and we are happy. So  
you see the Lord has done much  
for me in bringing me from the  
life of a wild Indian to that of a  
civil Christian. I do feel grateful to  
him. I wish I could see your  
kind husband and talk over other days  
when he labored against such odds.  
I feel deep regret at learning of his  
sickness and I pray God to spare him  
yet awhile. He asked about some  
of the old Indians in the different tribes  
here. Many of them have passed away.
