I. Private Morgan & Co. 3^d Infantry is hereby detailed on daily duty as Black in these Headquarters and will report immediately to 2^d Lieut Philip Reade 3^d Infantry, A. Post Adjutant for duty.

II. All Enlisted men belonging to the Companies of this Command on Extra or daily duty in the g. m. Dept, are hereby relieved and will report as soon as practicable to their Company Commanders for duty.

III. In pursuance of instructions received from Headquarters District Upper Arkansas in the field dated November 10-1864 - Privates George Hart, Charles Walker and Charles Steenberg "A" Co. 3^d Infantry are hereby relieved from duty with their Company, and will report to Post Major Henry Inman Chief g. m. District Upp. Ark, for Extra duty in g. m. Dept.

Upon the expiration of the term of service of these men the Commanding Officer of their Company will forward to Post Major H. Inman their statements and discharges.

No 201

The following regulations are hereby prescribed for the government and instruction of the scouts belonging to this Post. They will be obeyed accordingly.

Mr John C. Austin, Post Interpreter, will for the present, perform the duties of Chief of Scouts and all orders given by him to subordinates will be by them promptly obeyed. He will be held responsible for the enforcement of his own orders.

Each scout on being employed will be furnished with a hose, coarse, and equipment for which he will separately receipt. And should either be lost or abused unnecessarily, he will be charged with their full money value, in case that he runs down his hose without justifiable cause, it will be taken from him, and he will be required to perform all the duties of a scout dismounted.
