II Lieut Bassett 7th of Cav. with one (1) Serjeant (1) Corporal and fifteen (15) men of "B" Co. 7th of Cav. fully mounted & equipped, is hereby ordered to proceed to where two men were killed by Indians on the 12th inst. there to take up the trail & attack any party or parties of Indians near where the depredation was committed. This detail will be furnished with three (3) days rations. A Surgeon Bykes 1st Lt will accompany this detachment.

III Lieut Philip Reade 3rd of Infantry with ten (10) men of "B" Co. 7th of Cavalry fully mounted & equipped is hereby ordered to proceed to Mr. Widders Rancho & scout the country thoroughly in that vicinity & attack any party or parties of Indians near where depredations have been committed. This detachment will be furnished five (5) days rations.

IV Corporal Harten Co. "A" 3rd of Infantry with one (1) private from "A" Co. two (2) privates from "F" Co. and two (2) privates from "H" Co. 3rd of Infantry is hereby detailed to proceed to the Rancho of Mr. Widders and remain
