

The Indian captives now at this Post, to Fort Hays, Kansas. It is ordered that the commanding officer of the detachment at this Post, to be in charge of the prisoners, shall regulate his rate of travel so as to be in accordance with that of 1st Lieut. James M. Cornell 5th Regt. of Supply, when returning to Fort Hays, and will exercise every precaution to prevent, by any means, the escape of any of the prisoners confined to his charge. He will be accompanied by Mr. John C. Austin, Post Interpreter, &c.

This duty completed, Lieut. Wallace will return to this Post without delay accompanied by Mr. Austin.

III 1st Lieut. M. C. Gordon 19th Kansas Vol. Cavalry with sixty, (60) men of the detachment under his command fully armed and equipped, is hereby ordered to report without delay to 1st Lieut. Thos. S. Wallace, 3rd U.S. Infantry for orders, and the assignment to special duty.

IV 2nd Lieut. N. C. Litchfield, 19th Kansas Vol. Cavalry now at this Post, having unconditionally ordered his resignation as 2nd Lieut. N. V. Co., is hereby ordered to report to 1st Lieut. Thos. S. Wallace, 3rd U.S. Infantry with a view to proceeding to Fort Hays, Kansas. The acting chief, he will report to Brig. Gen. C. M. Hoover, Assist. Adjutant General, Dept. of the Mo., for further instructions.

V Sergt. James Tegan, Co. "H", 3rd U.S. Infantry, will report to 1st Lieut. Thos. S. Wallace, 3rd U.S. Infantry without delay for orders and assignment to special duty.

VI Mr. John C. Austin, Chief of Scouts & Post Interpreter is hereby ordered to report to 1st Lieut. Thos. S. Wallace, 3rd U.S. Infantry in charge of Indian captives with the view of accompanying him to Fort Hays, Kansas, which duty having been completed, he will return without delay to this Post.

VII Private John Hanson, Co. "A", 19th Kansas Vol. Cavalry, having reported at this Post in compliance with Special Order No. 167, Extract, Headquarters Fort Leavenworth, Kansas Dec 24th 1868, is hereby attached to Lieut. M. C. Gordon's Detachment 19th Kans. Vol. Cavalry, in duty at this Post until a suitable opportunity presents itself to rejoin his proper Company.
