The band pass at the general stations will only be used by the troops thereat in case when it may be necessary to move to a point threatened by an attack, or to convey important information concerning duty along the line, in a telegraphic station. Whenever it becomes necessary under this order to use a hand pass the utmost care and watchfulness is required upon the men not to interfere in any way with the running of the rail road train and when short a point, the hand pass must be returned from the track.
