





Remarks

Marched up sand Creek to a spring while a party of hunters (five in number) were encamped  
Water and grass no wood.

Road leave Cimarron and passes out a Mesa to Sand Creek. Water here in holes for a small  
party. Grass scarce. No wood.

Marched down the valley to Great bend of the Cimarron the wagon on the road. Passed this  
A.M. a hunters camp a number of buffalo hides were spread on the grass to dry the party  
having gone to the north fork of the Cimarron where were plenty of buffalo as stated on a  
paper left in camp.

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
