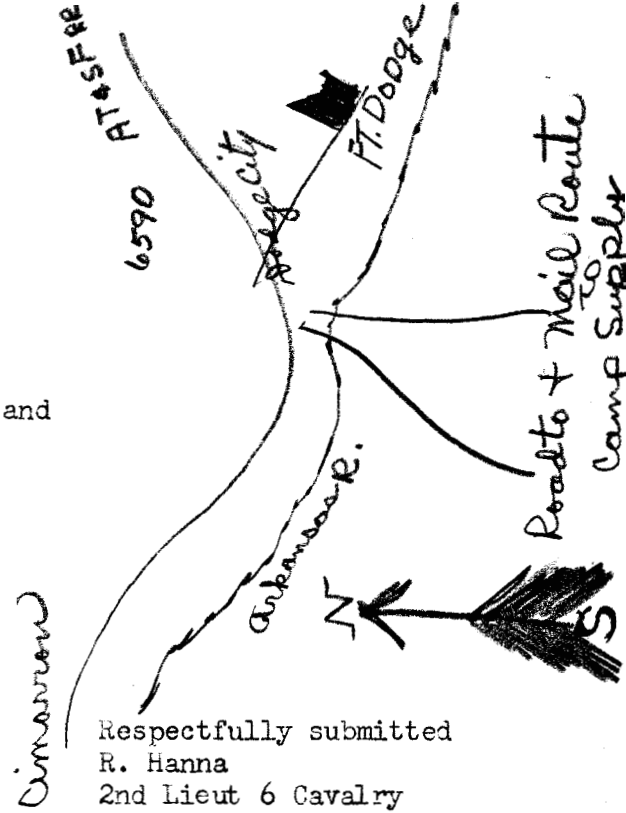


CONTINUED

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Aug 24, 74

Left camp at Cimarron at 5 P.M. and continued down the Arkansas, No change in General Character of the country. Passed through Dodge city and and took road leading to Fort Dodge where we arrived at 2 P.M. Distance travelled 23 miles and 720 yds.

Oct 21, 74

Left Fort Dodge Kan at 8.30 A.M. and travelled nearly a westerly direction to Dodge city crossed the Arkansas on the toll bridge and travelled along a good wagon road on the southern banks of the river in a nearly westerly direction to C N-1. The road runs in the bottom of the Arkansas which is sandy and covered with high grass. This valley is enclosed by sand hills. I arrived at C No 1 2:15 P.M. water and grass good and abundant but only few single trees and little drest wood. Distance travelled 18,262 yds. the command was delayed on the road owing to an accident to Sgt. Ashley in which his left arm was broken above the elbow.
