

I entered Carlisle. Born December 1868 entered school October 7th 1879.

It was while I was working for John Wanamaker in Philadelphia that I saw the ad. in a paper that Sitting Bull, the man who killed Custer would be in the city. It cost \$.50 to see him but I do not remember the name of the hall.

The place had quite a good sized stage. On the drop in the back was hung all the Indian goods. Baby cradles, travoise, leggings, moccasins, and all fancy bead work.

There was three men beside Sitting Bull, two women and two children, making 8 Indians in all. The white man got up and said he would have Sitting Bull speak. He led the old man to the front of the stage, and Sitting Bull began in this way. "My white friends, I have been traveling around among you, and I see you are very plentiful. So I intend going to Washington to shake hands with the Great White Father, and tell him I want all my children to receive the white man's education."
