What Indians were killed?

The answer is on question #15.

What Indians counted coup that day? You say they killed 2 soldiers in tents. Who killed these soldiers?

They were killed but I don't know who killed them?

Did they kill the soldiers with shooting, or hand-to-hand?

They were killed with Arrows.

Which direction from the main camp (fort) of the soldiers was the tents where the two soldiers were killed? How far was it?

South about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile.

Did the Indians get any horses that day?

I don't know.

I mention to Crazy Horse here but one of them was just name after the real Chief Crazy Horse. I put #2 on the other, New Crazy Horse.
