The action continued from nine o'clock until twelve o'clock when a party from the post under command of Brevet Lieut. Col. B. F. Smith, Major, 27th Infantry, made its appearance and the Indians retired leaving their dead and dying on the field. At the lowest estimate the Indians lost sixty killed and one hundred and twenty wounded. The following is a list of casualties:
