

drove up stream, both on & off horses but Ind tracked them & found them at noon as the sold were breaking camp - about 1,000 sold. - some wagons also.

There was both shooting at each other for a while then cavalry charge from SW & Ind retreat then charge & charge these few sold & drive them back to the main group - Ind on both N & S of sold.

Another bunch of sold, start E & charge Ind. - then Ind. charge cavalry & chase them across powder R. & back to main group.

Sold in timber on bottom, beside hill on N side P. River. -
(2nd chg. E sold cross River for chg)

The 1st chg was SW - an Ind named Stand looking Back - riding sorrel horse with only Sabre - chg whole bunch of sold & ran among them & knocked one sold off horse - when sold were retreating. - then same Ind. went to E. & chg again.

B.H. & S.L.B. chg together this time & each knock a sold off.

as white sold were retreating & Bull Head ~~each~~ knocked a sold off his horse - then Bull Eagle counted coup - all 3 very brave men for charging them alone. When sold turned around - whole infantry turns south - Ind. named Bear Buffalo charged & got as near as 20-30 yds when sold fired killing horse & man.

2/28 (near mouth of Little Colorado River) Ft. July p. 205
Powder R. flows towards E to Mt.

J.B. with bunch on East.

W.B. - - - also.

2 men wounded on East named - Long Ghost - my father bro. - my uncle - in right leg & also horse - pulled thru - Red Leaf - of SB tribe - in rite side of body - pulled thru

- SB didn't count coup.

SB had gun & B.H. & Sorrel Horse - wore 2 feathers

- war paint on ~~face~~ - shield like rainbow in sky - & painted round face likewise (rainbow)
