were told SB. arrive F. Peck 12 & other Ind. takeoff
hadden? - never heard

Ind. ever take feathers from hair to show
respect to hi-er chiefs? no. - never heard of such.

Method of above? 2 way. -

1. If in same camp & he comes in
my tent - I fix prominent place
for him to sit & while he was present
no one moved nor made a noise
2. If hadn't seen chief for some time -
go put arm around him & feel him
all over shoulders & arms.

3. Sometimes chief carried on buff robe? yes.
SB. above? - 1 & 2 but not 3

1 & 2 several times - one day by
almost time or camp by 2. when he
returned after wound in arm - He
nearly got killed & they were glad he
wasn't.
