Rainy Butte, at the head of Cedar Creek, took place  
a battle Sioux and Crows. The Crows made a  
charge on the Sioux but were repulsed. In  
this fight Jumping Bull and a Crow warrior  
had a hand to hand combat in which Jumping  
Bull was stabbed and killed.

Crow women and children were behind  
and were captured and brought <sup>to</sup> Sitting Bull.  
The Sioux wished to kill the Crow captives but S.B.  
did not wish this done. He said: "If you intend  
to do this for my sake - take good care of them and  
let them live. My father is a man and death is his."  
They were released at once and returned to their people.
