When the Nez Perces went into Canada I understand they had a council with the Red Coats, The Royal Northwest Mounted Police. Is this true? What was said at this council?

After we left Sitting Bull and the Sioux we met first Capt. Sehey, Canadian Soldier red coat, a half breed called Bull Head (red coat), Capt. Montors (red coat) Bull head asked if we were Nez Perces. We told him yes. We just came into Canada. Capt. Sehey said he was surprised that U. S. soldiers should drive their Indians out of the country and that it was alright for them to be in Canada.

These Canadian soldiers even issued rations to the Nez Perces-- to a few who were there at the time. They told us we could select land and live on it. About 80 took land but left it the yext year and came home.
