Do you know how the different men of Sitting Bull's camp were rated by their coups? How many did Sitting Bull have? Crazy Horse? Gall? What man in the Hunkpapa tribe had the most coups? ~~as a result of~~ Sitting Bull had 30

Crazy Horse 48. both white & Red. Gall had 20 - (see back of page)  
Who was considered the greatest leader of war parties?

Rain-in-the-face and Crazy Horse and afraid-of-Hawk  
The word "coups" is not Sioux, but a Crow Indian word.  
Sioux translation for "coups" is "Aopagan." (see back of page)

Who was the best at capturing horses?

Dog Eagle, who is still living at Little oak creek, S. D.  
Standing Rock Res. over 89 years old. Another interesting item is that my grand father (Flying cloud) who was killed by the Crow Indians was considered as one of the best. He was ~~leader~~ leader of a war party known as "Cuts Himself". He was a Hunkpapa under Gall. These facts are from my mother, whom you met, when you were here last fall. The name of Flying cloud is mentioned in Wannmakers book, "The American Indian."

By the way, I have my grand father's name: Flying cloud. (marpiya-Kinyayapi)  
~~one feather~~, who is still living was a member of this war party when my grand father was killed.
