Sitting Bull and his warriors fought with the Crow Indians close to the big bend on the Missouri river. A hostile Crow Indian charged with a gun and Sitting Bull had a gun too. They both charged and both shot at the same time. Sitting Bull killed his enemy and his enemy shot Sitting Bull's foot.
