Jumping Bull and a Crow warrior had a hand to hand combat in which Jumping

Bull was stabbed and killed. Crow women and children were behind and were

captured and brought and turn over to Sitting Bull. The Sioux wished to

kill the Crow Captives but Sitting Bull did not wish this done. He said:

"If you indend to do this for, my sake take good care of them and let them

live. My father is a man and death is his! They were released at once

and returned to their people.

IX I have been told that the Sioux warriors were eagle feathers to show that their brave ddeds had been. What feathers did Sitting Bull wear?

I would like to know just what feathers he had a right to wear and why?

Sitting Bull wears his eagle feather laying cross ways for bravery. When he reached the position of chief over all the chiefs, he were his eagle feather standing straight up.
